BOARDING

'The quality of boarding is **excellent**'

Boarders at Headington are confident, articulate, tolerant and considerate. The inspectors noted that the quality of the boarding provision and care is **excellent** and provides for each pupil's needs and that at Headington the boarders are exceptionally well looked after.

The boarders contribute to the smooth running of the boarding houses, live and work well together and develop a mutual respect that permeates all aspects of their lives. The



refurbishment programme has created high quality accommodation and recreational areas that are both nodern and welcoming.

> The Headmistress and Governors have a clear vision for boarding and the leadership and management of the boarding provision are **excellent**. The girls have a wide

range of school and house-based activities to choose from throughout the week and at weekends and the boarders feel **safe and secure** in their houses.

PARENTAL LINKS

'Links with parents are **excellent**'

Parents are overwhelmingly supportive of the School and satisfied with the information they receive, with regard to both the progress of their daughters and news from school. The inspectors observed that reporting is frequent and detailed, and targets are clear.

WELFARE, HEALTH AND SAFETY

The safeguarding of pupils of all ages is a very high priority and **the leadership of safeguarding is strong**.

The provision for sick pupils and those with SEND is of an extremely high standard and the health centre is staffed by qualified nurses, with a high proportion of staff trained in first aid.

GOVERNANCE

'The quality of governance is **excellent**'

The governing Council comprises an excellent blend of professional expertise in education business, finance and medicine and gives strong support to the leadership and senior team in advancing further the excellent breadth and quality of educational opportunities for pupils.

Governors have been fully supportive of the leadership's successful drive to improve the quality of teaching. Governors discharge very effectively their responsibilities for monitoring standards, financial planning and investment in staff, accommodation and learning resources.

Leadership at every level is committed to excellence in all aspects of school life. The sustained focus on excellence at Headington is a significant contribution in supporting pupils' achievements in public examinations and extra-curricular activities and their outstanding personal development

ACHIEVEMENT AND LEARNING

'The quality of the pupils' achievements and learning is **excellent**'

Pupils show **excellent** levels of knowledge, understanding and subject skills, which develop well as they move through the school. The girls have outstanding reading, speaking and listening skills in a range of subjects, high levels of artistic creativity and **excellent** mathematical skills across the curriculum. Many individuals achieve notable success in academic competitions, from English and Languages to Science and robotics. Results in International GCSE are higher than worldwide and UK averages, A Level results are **excellent** in relation to the national average and pupils who take the International Baccalaureate (IB) achieve results that are exceptional compared with worldwide averages and well above the UK average.
